The proposed plant will have a production capacity of 13tons/day combined for both liquid oxygen and nitrogen, 24tons/day Carbon-dioxide (Co2) and 500kg/day Dissolved Acetylene (DA) project and associated facilities include administrative building, car park, site clinic etc.

EVALUATION AND SELECTION CRITERIA

Submissions will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Successful completion and submission of all required documents and information. Failure to provide any eligibility requirement (as applicable) will result in disqualification from the selection process.
- Demonstrated industry experience, technical expertise, and the scope of service coverage.
- Satisfactory and relevant references from previous engagements.
- Only submissions that meet all eligibility requirements and pass the evaluation will be shortlisted for the next stage.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

All existing vendors with expertise in any referenced category are required to participate in this exercise.
